TOCCOA CITY COMMISSION
July 13, 2009

The City Commission of the City of Toccoa met in Regular Session at City Hall on Monday, July 13, 2009, at five o'clock P. M. with Mayor Ron Seib presiding.

The invocation was given by Pastor Paul Garrison followed by the Pledge Of Allegiance to the Flag.

Motion by Commissioner Austin, seconded by Commissioner Pavliscsak and unanimously carried to approve the Agenda as presented, a copy of this Agenda being attached as Exhibit "A."

Under Reports the following comments were heard:

Mayor Seib read a letter from Lisa Prickett, Executive Director of Stephens Education Literacy Foundation (SELF), thanking the members of the City of Toccoa Commission for continuing the financial support for this foundation.

Mayor Seib next recognized any visitors who wished to speak on any of the Agenda items. There were no persons present who wished to be heard.

- B. Consideration to Continue Telecommunications Tower Moratorium beyond July 21, 2009. Motion by Commissioner Pavliscsak, seconded by Commissioner Austin and unanimously carried to extend the moratorium for telecommunications antennae towers an additional 120 days.

III. NEW BUSINESS

- C. Bid Openings: Proposals for Auditing Services.
City Attorney Dickerson opened (4) four bids that were received. Motion by Commissioner Pavliscsak, seconded by Vice Mayor Troup and unanimously carried to remand this matter back to staff for their recommendation. City Manager will give a report at the next City Commission Meeting.
- D. Bid Openings: Commercial Front Loading Refuse Collection Truck. City Attorney Dickerson opened (8) eight bids that were received. Motion by Vice Mayor Troup, seconded by Commissioner English and unanimously carried to remand this matter back to staff for their recommendation. Motion by Commissioner Pavliscsak, seconded by Commissioner English and unanimously carried that a full cost analysis of Garbage Service be provided to the Commissioners.
- E. Consideration of Adoption of Comprehensive Plan Partial Plan Update and Short-Term Work Program as approved by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs. Motion by Commissioner Austin, seconded by Vice Mayor Troup and unanimously carried to adopt the resolution as presented.
- F. Recognition of Visitors Wishing to Speak:
