

Army Surplus Store

Constructed in 1906, this building stands as an example of the vernacular style of architecture commonly seen in the early 20th century. Early serving as an army surplus store, this building eventually made way for a bowling alley, a furniture store, a taxi company, and a pillow manufacturing business. Mr. Mike Van Minos purchased the building for State Farm Insurance and continues to operate two insurance agencies, State Farm and Metro Insurance Company, from this historic building.
