


## **Georgia Power**

This building has been home to many different types of businesses over the years. Originally the building housed Georgia Power—which was located here the longest. The building was also a Western Auto Store. More recently it has housed a hardware store, variety store, a Tae Kwon Do studio, and Whiten's Shoe Store. The building currently houses Details Salon 73.

When the gas station next door was torn down, this building became the western-most commercial structure on Doyle Street. The building was designed in the classical revival style with a pair of central doorways flanked by large plate glass windows. The building has been owned by the Terrell family for many years and looks much as it did when the building was built in 1936.
